FREE Resources

THE PREMIER PROGRAM of Safer Communities Australia is the **Safety Assist** (previously *Safety House*) scheme.

Our organisation has a number of resources that are available to schools to help in promoting the Safety Assist program to students and parents. *Resources include:*

- * **Safety Assist information brochures** – These would be ideal to include in school information packs to new parents and to have in front office and information boards.
- * **Safety Assist brochures for children** – These brochures are written especially for children and include information about Safety Assist and protective behaviours
- * **Activity sheets** – to assist in safety lessons and to help in the recognition of the Safety Assist sign, we have a large range of activity sheets that schools may copy. They include mazes, word searches, codes, colouring-in sheets and other work sheets that include safety messages.
- * **Bookmarks** – the bookmarks feature the Safety Assist sign plus safety messages
- * **Stickers** – these serve to remind children to look for a Safety Assist sign if they need help
- * **Safety Assist Posters** – the posters feature our mascot Safe T Hound and the Safety Assist message.
- * **Stay Safe posters** - these posters include a number of messages on how to *stay safe*.

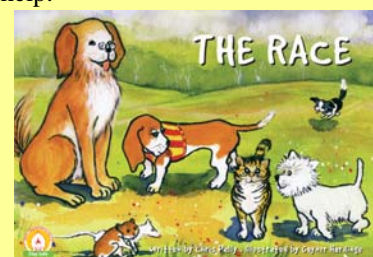
The Race - a story book
